

(as of June, 2008)







Average Age of Enrolled Students, 2005-08



Number of Students, Eligible to Enroll, by Programs and Gender





Number of Alumni Employed or Further Studying, 2003-07





Factors assisting in getting first job after graduating from KIMEP, 2006








Salary Level of KIMEP Alumni 2005 (USD)






