#### FOREWORD BY KIMEP UNIVERSITY PRESIDENT

It is my pleasure to present the eighth edition of the KIMEP University Fact Book.

KIMEP University is a non-profit institution of higher education, in which all proceeds are reinvested into the academic mission. Its aim is to develop well-educated citizens and to improve the quality of life in Kazakhstan and Central Asia through teaching, scholarship, and community service. KIMEP University offers graduate and undergraduate degree programs in business, law, economics, finance, accounting, public administration, international relations and regional studies, media management, and public relations. All programs are taught in English, and all curricula match the highest international standards.

In September 2013, all of KIMEP University's programs received accreditation from AQAAA, an internationally-renown agency with recognition from the Ministry of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan (MES of RK). A number of programs had previously also received accreditation. The undergraduate and graduate programs in Business Administration, including the

Executive MBA, hold accreditation from the Asian Forum on Business Education. The Executive MBA program is also accredited by the Federation for International Business Administration Accreditation, as the professional development program. The undergraduate and graduate programs in Public Administration are accredited by the European Association for Public Administration Accreditation, and the undergraduate and graduate programs in the Department of Journalism and Mass Communications are accredited by the American Communications Association. KIMEP University also holds institutional accreditation from the Independent Kazakhstan Quality Assurance Agency in Education (IQAA RK) and in April 2013 passed five-year state attestation.

The quality of KIMEP University's academic programs has been recognized by leading Kazakhstani rating agencies. IQAA RK has awarded KIMEP University the status of the Republic's "Best Humanitarian-Economic University" and the Bologna Center of the MES of RK has rated the Accounting and Audit, Economics and Public Administration programs as the best in Kazakhstan.

Furthermore, the quality of KIMEP University's programs maintains high approval ratings both from students and from the companies that employ them upon graduation. KIMEP University alumni comprise nearly half of all employees at the Almaty offices of the so-called "Big 4" auditing firms. Well over 90% of all alumni find employment within three months of graduation, a statistic not matched by any of the leading universities in North America, East Asia or Europe.

KIMEP University's world-class faculty has the largest concentration of Western-trained PhDs in the CIS. Our multicultural faculty plays a fundamental role not only in educating our students in their academic disciplines, and also in preparing them for their role as global citizens. Our international profile has continued to grow over the last year. KIMEP University now has partnerships with over 100 international universities, of which 30 are ranked in the Top 200 by the *Times Higher Education Supplement*. This includes ten dual degree programs with institutions in Europe, North America and the Republic of Korea.

KIMEP University bases all of its activities on its core values. These include integrity, freedom of academic thought, transparency and meticulous care for the well-being of students, faculty, and staff. KIMEP University is also proud of the active role that students play in the decision-making process. Students have representation on all key committees, and the university's administration regularly consults with the KIMEP Student Association, which serves as the elected student government. Our student body comes from all social and economic backgrounds, and includes international students from more than fifty countries. At KIMEP University, they participate in an array of extra-curricular, community service, and student government activities. When they graduate, they have acquired the knowledge, critical thinking ability, and professional skills necessary to become leaders of their societies.

The KIMEP Fact Book serves a key role in maintaining our total transparency to the public, giving all interested individuals the opportunity to have a complete picture of our operations. I hope that you enjoy learning more about KIMEP University. I am sure that you will find it to be an inspiring university worthy of serving the Republic of Kazakhstan for many generations to come.





## First university in Kazakhstan to receive full program accreditation from an international agency





Alumni of 2010-12: Fields of Occupation, %


